

## **Stormwater Advisory Committee Meeting**

**September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2007:**

- 1. CALL TO ORDER**
- 2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2007
- 3. Discussion of Staggered Terms-** The Town Council for the Town of Indian Trail adopted the Rules of Procedure for the Storm Water Committee in August 2007. These bylaws stated that the members will be appointed for staggered terms. Up until this point the committee members were all appointed at the same date with the same term lengths. The committee members decided term lengths for their current terms. This is so that the terms will be staggered for future appointment.
- 4. Impervious Surface Data for Non-residential-** Woolpert has calculated impervious data for all non-residential properties using 2004 aerials of Indian Trail. Patricia Malinowski with Woolpert presented the information to the Storm Water Committee. The Storm Water Committee discussed different options for rates of the Storm Water Utility. The presentation identified options for rates for both residential and non-residential properties.
- 5. Discussion of key items from August Meeting-** A quorum was not present at the August, 07 Storm Water Committee. Because of this, Patricia Malinowski opened up discussion on key items such as extent of services. The Storm Water Committee must identify these services for future operations.
