

Solid Waste and Recycling: News and Reminders

2024-2025 Solid Waste and Recycling Calendar

The new solid waste and recycling calendar will be mailed to residents this month for the period of Aug. 1, 2024, through July 31, 2025.

Important Dates to Note:

- The next Bulk and e-Waste service will occur:
 - Aug. 5-9 for Green recycling weeks
 - Aug. 12-16 for Orange recycling weeks

Subsequent Bulk and e-Waste pickups will take place in November 2024, February 2025, and May 2025. These dates are outlined in black on the calendar.

- Only three holidays will be on a solid waste delay:
 - Thursday, Nov. 28, 2024 (Thanksgiving)
 - Wednesday, Dec. 25, 2024 (Christmas)
 - Wednesday, January 1, 2025 (New Year's Day)

These dates are marked in black on the calendar. During these weeks, solid waste pickup will be delayed by one day after the holiday. All other weeks will run on a regular schedule.

- Free Shred Days will take place on:
 - Saturday, Nov. 9, 2024
 - Saturday, May 10, 2025

These dates are marked in yellow on the calendar.

If you have any questions, do not receive a calendar by Aug. 1, or need additional calendars, please call the Indian Trail Town Hall at 704-821-5401 and ask for Public Works.

Please call Town Hall at 704-821-5401 within 48 hours of not receiving bulk service so we can send a driver back promptly to pick up your items.

The Indian Trail Town Hall will be closed on Thursday, July 4, for Independence Day. We will resume normal business hours on Friday, July 5, at 9 a.m.

The July 4 holiday will **NOT** affect the solid waste pick-up schedule. Please put your trash and recycling/yard waste at the curb on your regular pick-up day.

Coffee with the Mayor



Stormwater Maintenance: Every Little Bit Helps

There are many ways you can help prevent the pollution of our stormwater. Here a few:

1. Don't wash your car in the driveway. Pull it into the yard so most of the wash water stays in your yard.
2. Don't wash the sidewalk with the hose. Instead, pick up litter and sweep the dust into a dustpan and discard it.
3. Try to control pests in your yard and garden without using chemicals. Ladybugs love to eat the aphids on your roses.
4. Follow landscape watering guidelines so you don't over water. Xeriscape with arid climate plants with lower water requirements.
5. Don't drain your pool, spa, hot tub or fountain into the storm drain on your street.
6. Don't throw litter on the street or dump anything into the storm drains.
7. Report any illegal dumping in the Town of Indian Trail by calling 704-821-5401.

Indian Trail Kicks Off Public Input for Community Center Feasibility Study

The Town of Indian Trail is in the beginning stages of a feasibility study to explore the possibility of building a multigenerational and multipurpose community center. And we need your input!

If constructed, the input from the community will be used to shape the facility, its offerings, and its footprint.

Public Input Opportunities

1. Initial Public Input Survey. Visit <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/ITRecCenter> or scan the QR code below to take a brief survey and give us your initial thoughts on a community center in Indian Trail. The survey will be open until Sept. 30.

2. Virtual and In-person Feedback. Later this year, we'll be hosting virtual and in-person meetings to answer questions and gather input. Our Parks and Recreation Department team members will also be available at events to talk about the proposed project.

3. In-depth Public Input Survey. A second more detailed public input survey will be available from Sept. 1 through Sept. 30.
