Manager's Report

- Town Manager McLaurin highlighted several items from the May 23 Manager's Report, which can be viewed on the Town's website at <https://www.indiantrail.org/DocumentCenter/View/4525/May-23-2025-Managers-Report>. Items he discussed included:
 - Susan Didier earning her Certified Assistant Tax Collector designation at the spring NCTCA conference.
 - Progress on Chestnut Parkway. Phase 3, which extends from Gribble Road to Old Monroe Road, is scheduled to be completed by this fall.
 - Several developers being interested in mixed-use projects near the 74 Bypass.
 - Safety and security upgrades at the Town Hall beginning in June.
- At the upcoming **June 12 meeting**, the Council will select a Grand Marshal for the July 4 Parade, appoint members to open Town board and committee seats, vote on the FY26 Budget, a pickleball court contract, and an Occupancy Tax referendum, and hear updates on the Emergency Operations Plan, Indian Trail Road Complete Street, street sweeping, and stormwater creek cleaning.
