- ARPA Stormwater Improvement Project: Supplemental Agreement #1 to the existing contract in the amount of \$37,728.
- The Notice of Award for the Bow Brook & Pioneer Lane Culvert Project to Birdsall Excavation Construction LLC in the amount of \$1,385,511.60.
- An agreement with The Lanti Foundation for the donation of a portable stage.
- Town of Indian Trail v. Stine - Indian Trail Road Complete Street Project Right-of-Way Acquisition
 - Payment of an additional \$19,300 in just compensation to Charles and Bettye Stine for parcel 5 right of way acquisition to settle case number 2400CV005285-890 – Town of Indian Trail v. Stine.
 - Payment of an additional \$29,050 to Charles and Bettye Stine for right of way acquisition for parcel 6 and agree to pave and re-stripe the existing unimproved parking lot on parcel 6 in conjunction with the project improvements and recommend that the 4th leg of the roundabout for EB-5931 be named "Stine Street" in recognition to Charles Stine's contributions to Indian Trail and the Indian Trail Pharmacy to settle case 24CV005293-890.
